PARC is a partnership set up under Horizon Europe to strengthen research and innovation in the assessment of risks, hazards and exposure to chemical substances. Bringing together communities working in the fields of public health, occupational health, food safety and environmental protection, PARC aims to develop research and innovation on new methodological approaches that can be used to assess the risk of chemical substances in today's and tomorrow's regulatory context, with a view to the Sustainable Chemistry Strategy.

PARC is also contributing to the implementation of human biomonitoring, and to collaboration between monitoring systems to facilitate the pooling of knowledge, methods and data with a view to an early warning system.
